******* Bred-By-Exhibitor Class Eligibility *******

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be **individually registered with the AKC**. The person handling the dog **must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog**. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

RT I-91 - Exit 10 (Rt. 40) to end, right onto Rt. 10 north (Whitney Ave), go approx.1 mile, turn left on Sherman Ave. (small Dunkin' Donuts sign), 0.9 miles, turn right on Corporate Ridge. Continue up Corporate Ridge to #36. The building is on the left.

Rt. 15 So. (Merritt Parkway): - Exit 62 (Whitney Ave., North), right onto Whitney Ave. Follow as above.

Rt. I-84: - Exit onto Rt. 691, first exit (Cheshire, Rt. 10, south), follow Rt. 10 through Cheshire into Hamden (Rt. 10, Whitney Ave.), take right onto Sherman Ave. (Dunkin' Donuts), follow as above.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two but not more than four of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in Stud Dog Class & must be shown in the ring with Get. Get must be entered in a regular class or in Best of Breed competition. Owner of Stud Dog need not be owner of get. \$12.00 fee for Stud Dog.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as above except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. \$12.00 fee for Brood Bitch

Brace Class: Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least **one common owner**. If a dog, which is to be part of the brace, is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only", fee of \$25.00 per dog, plus the \$12.00 fee for the brace as a unit.

Parade Of Veterans (Non-Competitive)

Open to all dogs and bitches (champions and non-champions) who, on the date of the show, are 7 years of age or older. Veterans for Parade may not be allowed to compete in any regular or non-regular class. Each entrant will receive a rosette. There is a \$10.00 entry fee.

Parade of Rescue Afghans (Non-Competitive)

Open to dogs and bitches adopted through Afghan Rescue. Minimum age of each entrant is 6 months on the day of the show. Each entry will receive a Special Medallion made specifically for the PARADE OF RESCUE suspended from a red, white and blue ribbon, offered by the Afghan Hound Club of America. [3] (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. [4] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. [1] (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

[2] The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

[3] (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

[4] A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
